
Wisdom of the Fathers

Commemorated July 26

Troparion, Tone 5:

Wise and praiseworthy martyr of Christ Parasceva: By accepting courage and rejecting feminine weakness You conquered the devil! You put your torturer to shame by crying out: Come, rend my body with your sword and burn it with fire, For I go rejoicing to Christ my bridegroom! By her prayers, O Christ God, save our souls!

Commemorated July 12

Troparion, Tone 8:

The image of God was truly preserved in you, O Mother, for you took up the Cross and followed Christ. By so doing, you taught us to disregard the flesh, for it passes away, but to care instead for the soul, since it is immortal. Therefore, O Holy Mother Veronica, your spirit rejoices with the Angels!

PENTECOST KONTAKION - Tone 8 - When coming down He brought confusion on mortal tongues, God Most High brought disunion to nations, and again when He apportioned the tongues of fire, He summoned all mankind to unite once more; and with one accord we glorify the All-Holy Spirit.
