**Prosperity, the known and the  
unknown, and the two ways**

# The blessed man is prosperous Ps. 1:1-3

A summary comparison:

Both Joshua and the Blessed man walk (*halak*) the same path (*dherek*), follow the same method (*hagah*) and prosper (*tsalakh*) all the time (*yomam valaylah*).

## Joshua 1:7-8

Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law which Moses my servant commanded you; turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go (*halak*). This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate (*hagah*) on it day and night (*yomam valaylah*), that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you shall make your way (*dherek*) prosperous (*tsalakh*), and then you shall have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; be not frightened, neither be dismayed; for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go (*halak*).

## Psalms 1:1-3

Blessed is the man who walks (*halak*) not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way (*dherek*) of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; <sup>2</sup> but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates (*hagah*) day and night (*yomam valaylah*).<sup>3</sup> He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers (*tsalakh*).

In what is the blessed man successful?

### **Isaiah 53:10**

Yet it was the *will of the LORD* to bruise him; he has put him to grief; when he makes himself an offering for sin, he shall see his offspring, he shall prolong his days; *the will of the LORD* shall prosper (tsalakh) in his hand.

### **Isaiah 55:11**

So shall *my word* be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish *that which I purpose*, and prosper (tsalakh) *in the thing for which I sent it*.
